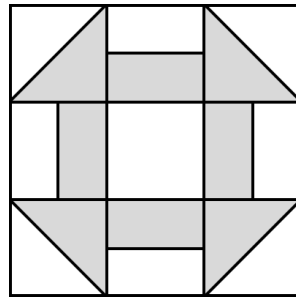
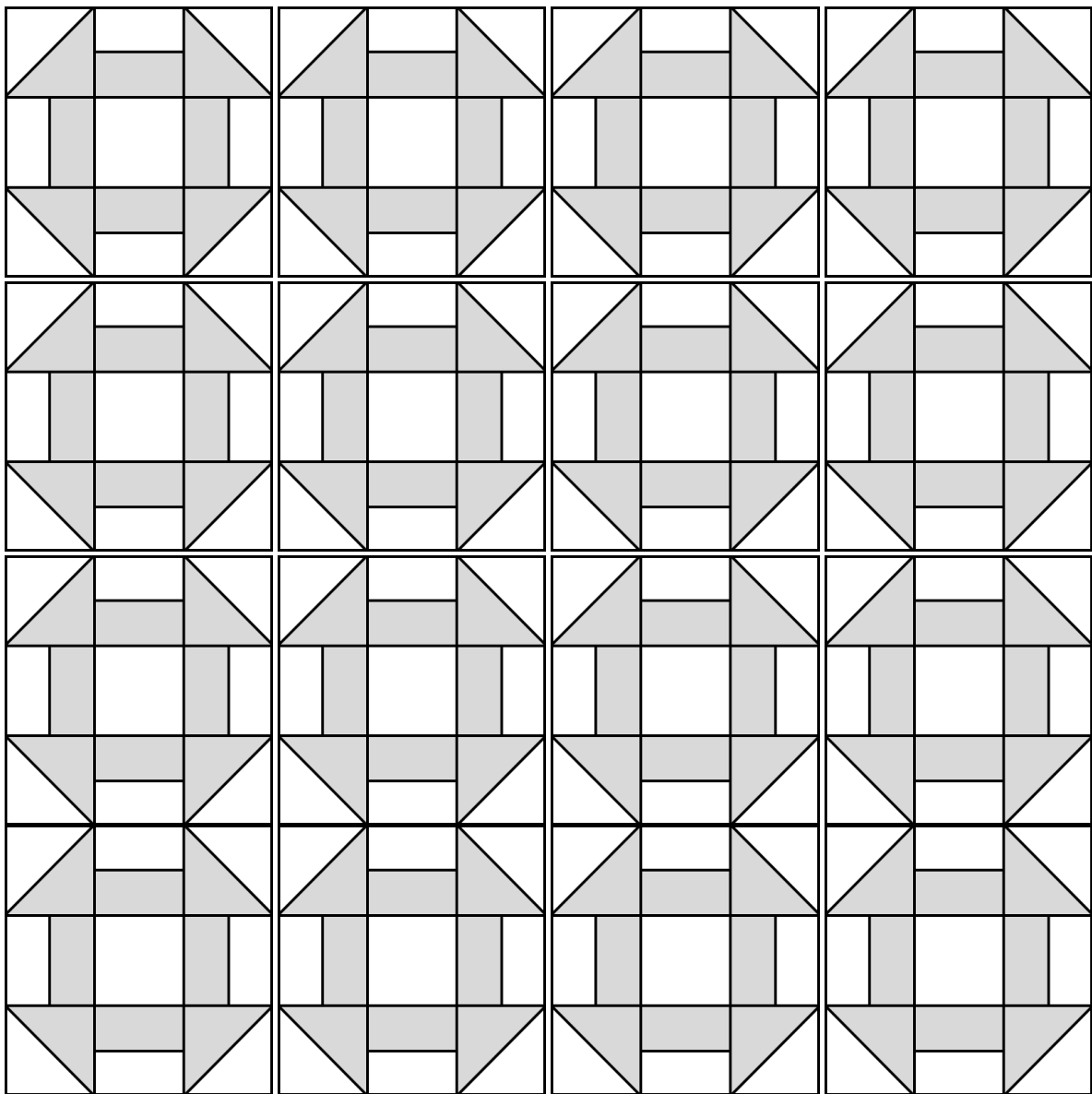


# Churn Dash



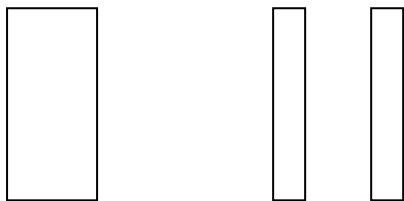
*Perfect for your stash builder kits.*

## CONSTRUCTION

1. Lay your 8" strips out and place two contrasting colours together.
2. Cut the strips into one 4" strip and two 2" strips.



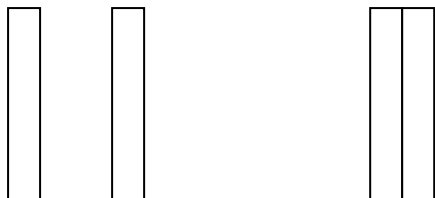
3. Cut 8 x 4" squares of the dark fabrics, 8 x 4" of lights of each fabric. Plus an extra light one, a little smaller – 16 X 3 1/2" squares, for the centre of the blocks.
4. Lay the 4" squares right sides together, 1 light and 1 dark. Use the Quickie Quarter (optional) to draw your lines diagonally, corner to corner.



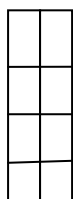
5. Sew on the outside lines and cut through the centre line. Otherwise draw a line and using your quarter inch foot sew either side of the line. Cut back to 3 1/2".



6. Press the seam towards the dark side.
7. Cut the 2" strips into 14" lengths for each block. Mix the different strips together so that you create various colour ways in your blocks.

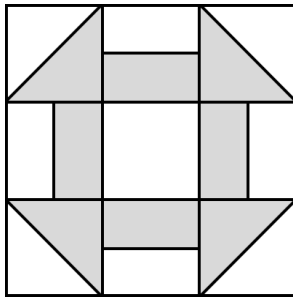


8. Sew the pairs together in the order you prefer, and crosscut into 3 1/2" squares.



9. Press the seam towards the dark side.

10. Lay the blocks out and sew together.



11. Place the blocks in a pleasing manner and sew together.

12. I used an extra 18" of fabric for the borders as I felt it looked better. I cut 4 x 4 1/2" strips for the borders to the length of the quilt. Sew the sides then top and bottom.

13. Then I sewed 2" strips together to form the binding

14. Choose a backing and wadding and pin together and Quilt.
